Raising money for The Air Ambulance


We raised a fantastic £120 for The Air Ambulance at December's Christmas quiz, in memory of Norman Carlisle. Thank you to all who came along and joined in.



# MALTHOUSE WELL

The Malthouse well reading bottomed out during December at 17.35 metres (57.0 ft) below ground level, but as we start the new year it has risen to around 16.9 metres (54.5 ft).

From the graph below we can see that the groundwater is in a similar position to the start of 2014 when we suffered from the terrible flooding. However there is a big difference between then and now because we have had only around 90mm of effective rainfall in the last 3 months which is less than half of the rain (approx 200mm) we had in the same period before the 2014 flood. So, unless there is a deluge in January we should be safe from groundwater flooding at the beginning of 2017.
